

When Should You Keep Your Child At Home?

(Quick reference, list is not all-inclusive)

1. Fever > 100.0 in the past 24 hours
2. Diarrhea > 2 episodes in the past 24 hours
3. Vomiting
4. Rash of unknown origin, until cleared by primary physician.
5. Head lice until treated and cleared by School Health Staff
6. Generalized fatigue and illness that will inhibit your child's ability to concentrate and be part of a group setting.
7. A cold that consists of cough, heavy congestion, runny nose
8. Conjunctivitis / "Pink Eye", until cleared by primary physician
9. Ring worm until treatment has started and must be kept covered
10. Strep throat until cleared by physician.
11. Any condition that is considered contagious.
